Must have a desire to continue work in the field of fine art or commercial art. 4. Applicant need not be a student in the art department. The scholarships awarded are to be used at an institution of higher learning; and will be paid to the school upon proof of enrollment in an art-related field.(required)

Presentation of art work for jury Wed, Apr 25: 1. Examples of art work from any art classes taken anywhere while high school age; and independent work you've done. Include your best work. 2. Sketchbook, reflects your skill development and exploration over time. 3. A Colorado poster. The poster should depict the state of Colorado from the artist's perspective, i.e. an activity, a place, or something that represents Colorado to you. Art work

will be judged on imagination, skill, originality and growth/ progression. The contents of the sketchbook may come from the student's imagination or life experience, and reflects the development of the artist—areas of exploration, focus, refinement, study, and processes--over time.(required)

Award Recipients: The judges will select up to 3 pieces of each award recipient's art work which will be on exhibit at the Palmer Lake Art Group's COLOR SPLASH Show in June at Tri Lakes Center for the Arts, and honored at the opening reception.
