Committee Reports:

- **Sunshine:** It was reported that Don Goodman has returned home following a short hospitalization.
- **Color Splash-** Bonnie Sands reported that TLCA requested that, due to COVID issues, the show be postponed once again until later in the fall.
- Following a discussion of the pros/cons of postponing the show further into the year, a motion was made by Irmi Knoth and seconded by Margarete Seagraves to cancel future shows at TLCA for the remainder 2020. Fees already paid to TLCA are to be carried over into 2021 for a future show.

Motion carried.

With relation to this decision, the following issues were discussed:

- PLAG has already printed publicity materials twice for this show and won't accrue the added expense of printing once again in 2020.
- Treasurer, Carolyn Stolz, will return entry fee funds to those who have already paid for the August date.
- With the help of Carolyn and Joanie Lang, Irmi Knoth will write to scholarship donors again to thank them for their support, to explain the cancellation, to deliver a letter with a tax exemption information and to enclose their donation certificate.
- An ad will be placed in the "Our Community News" to recognize and thank our donor sponsors.
- The juror for the August show will be asked to jury the next PLAG show.
- Bonnie Sands was recognized and thanked by the members for the work that she put into trying to organize the Color Splash Show during these difficult times.
- **Website:** Lynn Roth was thanked for his efforts in putting together the new Online Monthly Gallery on the PLAG website. Members were invited to upload three images each month for a rotating exhibit of work.
- **"Conquer the Quarantine" Contest:** The winner was Mark Dixon. Mark was thanked for donating his prize money to the PLAG scholarship fund.
- **Gallery Committee:** The Gallery Committee will meet on Wednesday, July 15th at 1 PM at the home of Vicki Mynhier. All are welcome—call for directions, if needed. Among other items, the committee will address a possible pre-holiday sale of artwork to replace the Craft Show. Also, the committee will explore the possibility of creating a PLAG Etsy store.

- Patricia Schmidt will be the "Artist of the Month" for the August meeting. She will explain her development as an artist with examples of her work.
